RULES OF LIBRARY

Government Degree College Kanvaghati Kotdwar has a well-maintained library for all the student of all classes at U.G. level. Books are issued to college students under the following rules-

- 1. Exchange/issued/return/distribution of books is applicable from 10.00 am to 2.00 pm on the working days. In this context, all students should check the notice board of the college.
- 2. Registration in E-granthalaya is compulsory for every student before issuing books. To complete registration processes students must submit their own mobile number and their email -id compulsory in the library.
- 3. Students will return the book within 15 days from the date of issuing date after which they must be returned or re-issued, depending on the discretion of the librarian.
- **4.** If a book at the time of returning to library is found defaced or damaged in any way, the last borrower will be required to pay its price as its damages **5.** Leave from the college does not imply exemption from returning library books.
- **6.** The loss of a book should be reported to the librarian before the due date. The borrower will be required to replace the book or pay double the price.
- 7. The librarian is empowered to recall any book at any time.
- **8.** Reference books, Rare books and Periodicals will not be issued except for consultation in the library during working hours.
- 9. The students are expected to observe perfect silence in the library and should

not disturb others in any way.

10. Any misuse of college library will be consider.

E-Granthalaya

E-Granthalaya is a Digital Platform developed by National Informatics Centre, Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology, Government of India for Government Libraries for Automation of In-house activities as well as member services and Networking for resource sharing. On this platform, NIC provides a complete ICT solution with integrated Library Management Software, Digital Library Module, Cloud hosting environment and a Library Portal (OPAC) with NICSI empaneled Roll-out Services and support. e-Granthalaya is useful to transform traditional libraries to e- Library with Digital Library Services and to provide various online member (Faculty and students) services using Single Window Access System. The E-Granthalaya has solved such problem without much investment. As a result of library computerization, a number of bibliographic databases are in existences, which are accessible by users with their desktop on the web.

In College Library the e- Granthalaya software has the Book Database which contains more than 8,000 books, journals, manuals, etc.
